Sessions Breakdown

Following is the 27-Session Breakdown for the A1 Integrated Course at EuroBhasha. It serves as a comprehensive guide to assist you in tracking the topics covered throughout the progression of the A1 Integrated Batch.

Session 1 (Grammer) Pronunciation rules, Personal Pronouns, Wquestions, Verb Endings

The goal of this class is that we should be able to make basic W - Questions in German. To reach that level, we learn some basic rules of pronunciation followed by personal pronouns (I, you, he, she) and finally the list of W-Questions in German.

Session 2 (Interactive German: Part 1) Greetings, Alphabets and Numbers till 10

In Session 2, we learn how to greet in German. We learn the alphabet of the German language followed by numbers from 1 to 10.

Session 3 (Interactive German: Part 2) W-Questions and Verb Conjugations

In this session, we learn numbers up to 100. We also practice W-Questions and Verb Conjugations.



Session 4 (Grammar) Special W-Questions, Time-related words, Position of Doer

We learn 5 special W-Questions in German. With that, we learn a list of time-related words like today/tomorrow/sometimes/never etc. We also learn about the position of the Subject (Doer) in a German sentence.

Session 5 (Interactive German: Part 3) Self Introduction (Part 1) – Professions

In this session, we learn how to introduce ourselves in German. Along with that, we learn how to tell the masculine and feminine versions of professions in German.

Session 6 (Interactive German: Part 4) Yes/No Questions

After learning W-questions, we learn the second and last type of questions in this session: Yes/No Questions. We learn how to talk to someone for the first time through Yes/No Questions.

Session 7 (Grammar) Articles, Nominativ and Akkusativ

This is one of the most important classes - here we learn the articles in German. Do you know that there are 12 forms of 'the' in German? In this class, we learn the different types of articles in German.

Session 8 (Interactive German: Part 5) Self Introduction (Part 2)

This session is dedicated to learning how to introduce ourselves in a more nuanced way. We have already had one class on self-introduction. In this session, we learn a more detailed version of self-introduction.



Session 9 (Interactive German: Part 6) Irregular Verbs, Filling-up forms

In this class, we learn two new types of verbs - Irregular verbs and Special verbs. These verbs have different rules of conjugations as compared to the normal verbs. Learning these verbs will add immensely to your vocabulary.

Session 10 (Grammar) Akkusative and Dative Prepositions, nicht/kein difference

In Session 10, we learn how to make negative sentences or negative questions in German. Along with that, we also learn prepositions in German. Prepositions are words like for/with/from/of/by etc.

Session 11 (Interactive German: Part 7) Self Introduction (Part 3), Family Members

This is the third and last class on self-introduction. Till now, we have learnt basic introductory sentences. In this class, we learn how to give an introduction in a much more detailed manner. We also learn how to talk about our family members in German.

Session 12 (Interactive German: Part 8) Shopping

In Session 12, we learn vocabulary related to shopping. For example, the conversations that take place at a grocery market or a clothing store. This helps us to speak basic sentences whenever we go for shopping.

Session 13 (Grammar) Wechselprepositions, Short Forms

Here, we learn the third and the final set of prepositions in German. These prepositions are called Changing Prepositions. We learn how to use words like in/under/on/behind/above etc. Along with these, we also learn some short forms related to prepositions.

Session 14 (Interactive German: Part 9) Objects and Things

This Session is dedicated to improving our vocabulary of nouns. We learn the names of many objects that are used in day-to-day life. With this, we also practice the Changing Prepositions.

Session 15 (Interactive German: Part 10) Ordering in a Restaurant

Very often, we go to restaurants and we don't know how to start a conversation there or how to order something from the menu. Session 15 teaches us to make the kind of sentences that we need to use in such situations. In this session, we also do a role play where we simulate a conversation at the restaurant.

Session 16 (Grammar) Fixed Prepositions, Separable Verbs

In most of the languages, there are some fixed prepositions used with things like day, month, time etc. In Session 16, we learn fixed prepositions in the German language. Along with this, we learn a new type of verb - the separable verb. This type of verb is very unique and it does not exist in English.

Session 17 (Interactive German: Part 11) Days/Months/Daily Schedule (Part 1)

In this session, we learn how to talk about our daily schedule in German. After this, we will be able to tell what we do from morning to night or from Monday to Friday in German. We also practice separable verbs and fixed prepositions in this class.



Session 18 (Interactive German: Part 12) Daily Schedule (Part 2)

This session is also dedicated to learning how to talk about daily schedules. We read texts detailing how people discuss their daily routines, and then we write our own text where we talk about our own schedules.

Session 19 (Grammar) Connectors, Modal Verbs

This is one of the most important sessions as here we learn the modal verbs. Modal verbs are words like can/must/should/want etc. With this, we learn how to use two verbs in a sentence. Also, we learn how to connect two sentences with the help of connectors.

Session 20 (Interactive German: Part 13) Modal Verbs Exercise

Modal Verbs are one of the most important topics in A1. Hence, this entire session is dedicated to the practice of modal verbs.

Session 21 (Interactive German: Part 14) Body Parts and Weather

In this session, we learn about the names of body parts and diseases in German. We will also learn vocabulary related to weather. After this session, we can discuss the weather with anyone.

Session 22 (Grammar) Future Tense, Imperative

In this session, we learn how to instruct/suggest/command/order in German. We learn imperative sentences. Imperative sentences are the sentences that we use when we tell someone to do something. We also learn how to make future tense sentences in German.

Session 23 (Interactive German: Part 15) Imperative Exercise

In Session 23, we practice Future Tense and Imperative Sentences.

Session 24 (Interactive German: Part 16) Exam Pattern Discussion

This session is dedicated to the discussion of TELC A1 Exam pattern. The trainer discusses what all sections are there in the exam and we will solve a couple of exercises from the model test paper.

Session 25 (Grammar) Dative Verbs

In this last grammar session, we learn the second case of dative. We learn dative verbs. Whenever there is a dative verb, then the object becomes dative.

Session 26 (Interactive German: Part 17) Exams - Oral Part and Reading Comprehension Practice

This session is dedicated to the practice of the Oral Exam section and Reading Comprehension Part of the TELC A1 Exam. We solve activities from both these parts and the trainer discusses strategies for these two parts.

Session 27 (Interactive German: Part 18) Letter Writing

In the last session of the A1 Integrated batch of EuroBhasha, we learn writing a letter/mail in German.
